Ashish Baran Mohanty

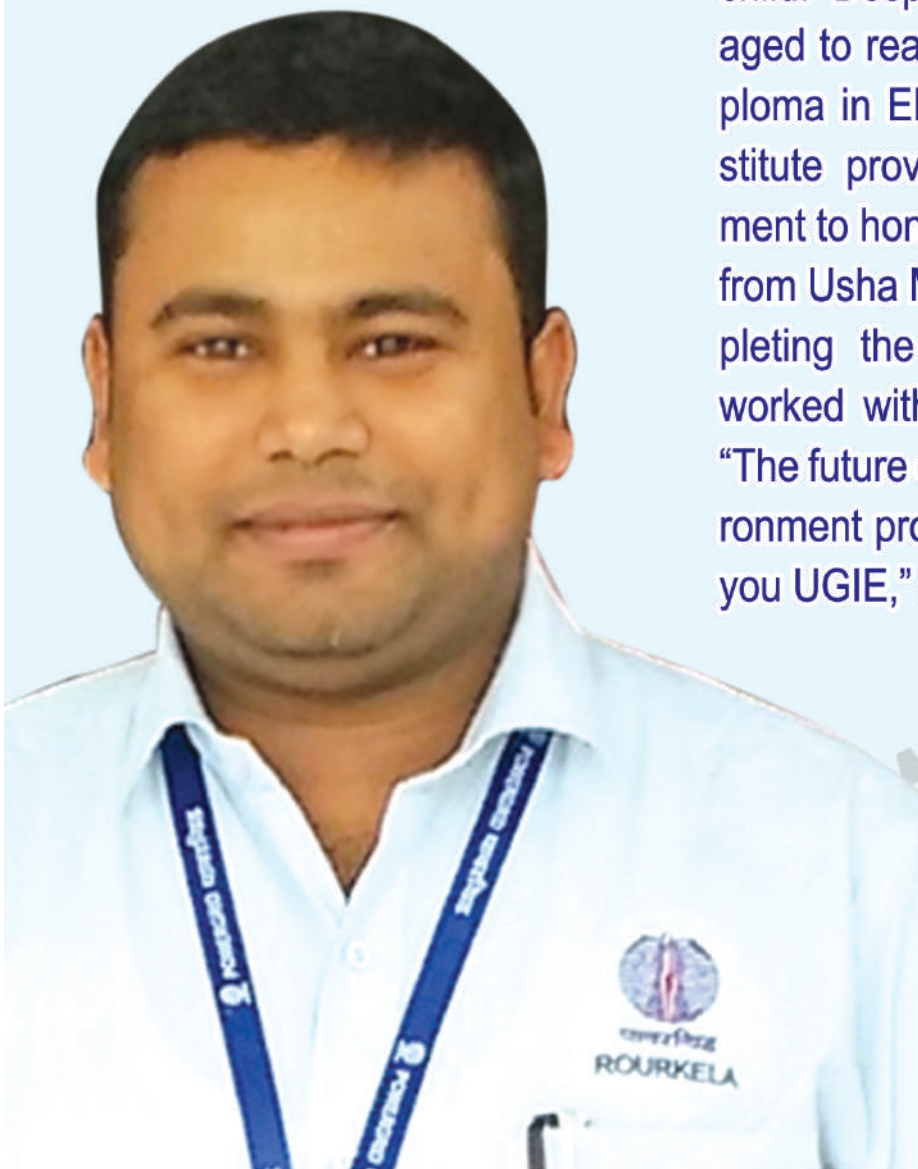
